

White Boards

Some classrooms may have a white board mounted on the wall for use for other classes. For videoconferencing, it may not be the best method because you will be writing with your back to the students and the primary camera will be focused on the board and not on you. You will have greater difficulty watching the monitor, so you may need a room operator to keep your work readable. You need to write with thick lines, and you probably can't display as much written material as you might in a traditional classroom. If there are other options such as writing on a visual presenter, we suggest using that.
